

Thornton-le-Clay Circular: c 2 ½ miles including 3 stiles.

Leave Thornton-le-Clay along High Street. Walk out of the village until reaching a T junction. Turn left along the road & continue until you see a footpath sign pointing left over a stile. This is opposite a track which is a bridleway. Go over the stile & continue, keeping the sheep-fencing on your right. Where the fencing takes a 90deg right angle, you will see a footpath sign pointing left. Follow the sign across the middle of the field. This track has been left as grass between the crops on either side. On reaching the hedge turn right, along the side of the field. At the end you will see another stile in front of you. Go over this & after 20m there is a stile in the left hand fence. In this field be aware of cattle. Go over the stile in the left hand fence & turn right, walking along the grassy strip. At the end, turn left & walk 20m where you will see a large gap in the hedge through which you can access the road. Turn left on the road back into Thornton-le-Clay.
