Need a Lifeline

... support for older people

An emergency response service - including weekly or monthly welfare visits - is available for older and other vulnerable people in Ryedale and Scarborough. It operates 24 hours a day, every day of the year.

The service provides a lifeline alarm unit linked to the telephone line in the home which when activated automatically dials a contact centre where help can be summoned. Contact centre staff will assess the caller's situation and organise the most appropriate help. A team of staff can respond day or night should local named responders not be available to attend.

There is a cost for the service but funding may be available for people who qualify.
